Digital Lunch & Learn Recap - Connecting Research with Policy

Digital Lunch & Learns provide an outlet for network members to discuss a specific, pre-determined topic between peers that share similar interests and serves as a sounding board/discussion forum.

Our New Researcher's Discussion Series - Connecting Research with Policy session aimed to help connect

students, researchers, and practitioners with policy and policy makers. Of 14 registrants, 6 attended (1 practitioner, 1 researcher, and 4 students) because the topic related to their current work and research interests. All participants said that they would recommend future Lunch & Learns to others and attendees were satisfied or somewhat satisfied (50%/50%) with the overall session. Using zoom as the platform, round table facilitation, and Q&A feedback discussion was deemed useful by all that contributed.
